### HELD UNDER THE GENERAL COMPETITION RULES OF THE MCUI AND THESE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The trial will be held over a number of laps of a circuit. On each lap the competitor will be required to negotiate a number of observed sections. The number of laps will be stated before the start.
2. The observers' decision is final.
3. The Punch Card method of recording marks will be used.
4. No practising, either on or before the day will be permitted. Any competitor found doing so might be disqualified.
5. Machines to be fitted with standard tyres not exceeding 4" cross section and unaltered in any way.
6. All competitors must be in possession of a 2004/2005 competition licence which must be available for inspection. Otherwise a one event licence will be required at a cost of £5.00
7. Helmets as per MCUI(UC) Ltd. regulations must be worn.
8. Competitors are requested to wear their grade identity bibs for all Ulster Championship events.
9. Any Ulster Centre Competitor injured in this event and wishing to claim from the Benevolent Fund, must do so in writing together with Competition Licence, within 14 days to the Treasurer of the Ulster Centre Ltd by submitting a form obtained from the Club Secretary within 14 days of the event.
10. **Personal Accident Insurance** is compulsory for Ulster Centre Licence holders riding in Ulster Centre Events run under an Ulster Centre Permit. Complete responsibility for effecting this cover lies with the competitor, and Ulster Centre Officials will not carry out checks.
11. The trial will be observed using the FIM Stop Rules.
12. If a rider has the assistance of a Minder, the Minder must complete an entry form and sign on. The Minder must wear the same protective clothing as a competitor at all times and is not allowed to ride the sections.
13. The time limit for the event will be displayed at the start; the penalty for exceeding this limit will be exclusion. All punch cards, including those of retired riders, must be returned to timekeepers.
14. Photographs may be taken during both Junior and Adult events and used in conjunction with editorial articles published on the internet and in local and national press.
