This event is held under the general competition rules of the MCUI(UC) Ltd, these regulations and the UC supplementary regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1- The trial will be held over a number of laps of a circuit. On each lap the competitor will be required to negotiate a number of observed sections, the number of laps and sections will be announced at the start.
- 2- The onus on following the correct course lies with the competitor and all sections must be attempted in the correct order with punchcards punched by the observer of the section.
- 3- No practising, either on or before the day of the event will be permitted. Anyone found breaking this rule would be excluded.
- 4- **All competitors must be in possession of a current competition licence, which must be available for inspection. If current licence cannot be produced then a one-day licence must be purchased.**
- 5- All competitors must wear helmets as per MCUI regulations.
- 6- In the event of a tie for any place, the competitor with the greater number of cleans, one's etc will be the winner.
- 7- Any competitor injured in the event may claim Benevolent Fund by submitting a form obtained from the club secretary within 14 days of the event.
- 8- The starting procedure will be as follows:
 - Grade D & Youth B competitors will start at 11-30am
 - Grade C & Youth A competitors will start at 11-40am.
 - Grades A & B will start at 11-50am.
 - Youth C will have their own short course and will start at 11-30am.
- 9- The trial will be observed under the current MCUI rules.
- 10- Personal accident insurance is compulsory, for Ulster centre licence holders, riding in Ulster Centre events, run under an Ulster Centre permit. Complete responsibility for effecting this cover lies with the competitor; the Ulster Centre officials will not carry out checks. Insurance is available on the day, to any competitor who requires it, at £3 per event or £30 per year.
