- Eligibility.** The event is open to drivers, on solo motorcycles, holding a current competition licence issued by the MRA, MCUI(SC), ACU, SACU or Continental FMN'S and none licence holders.
- Entries must be made on an official form properly completed, signed and paid (1 fully completed entry per team member).
The entry will be £45 stg 1or 2 man team
£60 stg. 3 man team

- A driver MUST NOT race without signing on and presenting themselves & machinery to the scrutineers.
- All competitors must wear protective clothing and 2011 stamped Crash Helmets of the types as per MRA Reg.

- Finish of a Race – After 3 hours the flag
- Any rider refusing medical attention **WILL NOT** be allowed to race further that day.
- No Dogs or any other animals will be permitted at this venue.
- No scooters, paddock bikes, run about m/c or bicycles will be permitted at this venue.
- Safety Flags Signals YELLOW / RED FLAG** – As per MRA Rules Failure to obey flag signals will entail **DISQUALIFICATION**.
