SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Personal accident insurance is recommended for Ulster Centre Licence holders, riding in Ulster Centre events, run under an Ulster Centre permit. Complete responsibility for affecting this is with the competitor.
2. The trial will be open to Solo Motorcycles only, fitted with standard tyres not exceeding 4 inches in width.
3. The trial will be over a number of laps on private ground, each lap having a number of observed sections, and all sections must be attempted. These sections will be indicated by Yellow markers at the start and White markers at the finish of the section.
4. The front wheel spindle of the machine will be used in determining whether the machine is in or out of the section.
5. The Trial will be observed using the FIM non-stop rules.
6. In the case of a tie for any award, the competitor best in observation where time is lost will be the winner, then greatest number of cleans, ones, etc.
7. Safety Helmets must be worn as per M.C.U.I. (UC) Limited regulations.
8. Any Ulster Centre Competitor injured in this event and wishing to claim from the Benevolent Fund, must do so in writing together with Competition Licence, within 14 days to the Treasurer of the Ulster Centre Limited.
9. Competitors are requested to wear their Grade identification Bibs/or colour plates for Ulster Championship points.
10. Minders must complete an entry form and sign on, wear Identity bib, and wear same protective clothing as a competitor at all times. Minders must not ride section
