Held under the Motor Cycle Union of Ireland and Motorcycle Racing Association Ireland General Competition Rules, Standing Regulations for Trials and these Supplementary Regulations.

1 Riders must sign off at the end of the event or when they retire.

2 Open to:

Adult grades: Expert Elite, Expert, Semi-Expert, Clubman, Sportsman.

Junior grades: YA, YB and non-Championship YC.

There will be no separate junior course for YC, YD & YE at this event.

3 Grading as per current MCUI 2024 Grading List.

4 The Trial will involve a number of laps on private ground with each lap having a number of Observed Sections. The Sections will be indicated by yellow and white markers at the start and end respectively. Within the Sections, each grade shall negotiate their respective coloured gates. All Sections shall be attempted in the correct order.

6 If a rider is accompanied by a Minder, the Minder must sign on and pay the appropriate fee. The Minder must wear the same protective clothing as a competitor at all times and is not allowed to ride the Observed Sections.

7 Only signed-on competitors, minders and event officials' motorcycles are permitted on the course. Competitors and Minders, other than event officials, are not permitted on the course prior to the event start times. Penalty – exclusion from the Trial results.

8 Riders are required to wear a bib or display a coloured board to denote their grade.

9 Use of Power Washers at the venue is strictly prohibited.

10 COVID-19: Anyone experiencing symptoms of Covid-19 must not attend the event.

11 Riders' performance in Observed Sections will be recorded on punch cards. All punch cards, including those of retiring riders, must be returned to the Timekeepers.

12 The Trial will be observed in accordance with the MCUI non-stop rules.

13 Results will not be available immediately following the event but will be posted on-line in due course.

14 Entries to be received on or before the closing date (**Thursday 23rd November 2023**).
