Held under the Standing Regulations & Sporting Code, the Trials Rule Book of the Amateur Motor Cycle Association (AMCA) and these Supplementary Regulations.

- 1 Riders must sign off and return their swipe cards at the end of the event or when they retire.
- 2 **CLASSES:** Expert, Semi Expert, Clubman, Sportsman, Junior YA, YB, YC(main course). There will be no separate YC, YD & YE course at this event.
Grading as per MCUI 2024 Grading List.
- 3 **AWARDS. PREMIER:** RUSK MEMORIAL TROPHY.
Semi-Expert: ARTIE BELL TROPHY. Clubman: DAVY ANDREWS TROPHY.
Sportsman: DON PERRY TROPHY. Junior A: DAVID McBRIDE CUP
- 4 The Trial is a round of the BILLY McGIVERN TROPHY. This is awarded to a Semi-Expert rider who is an Ards Club Member prior to the Bedford Cup Trial, with the lowest total marks lost in the Bedford Cup, Turner Trophy, Boxing Day and Sandown Trophy trials. In the event of a tie the best performance in the Turner Trophy will win the award. Eligibility is determined from the Grading List at the time of the Turner Trophy Trial.
- 5 If a rider has the assistance of a minder, the minder must sign on and pay the appropriate fee. The minder must wear the same protective clothing as a competitor at all times and is not allowed to ride or alter the sections.
- 6 Power washing at the venue is prohibited.
- 7 Only signed-on competitors, minders and event officials' motorcycles are permitted on the course.
- 8 No riding in car park, pedestrian lane or prohibited areas (Shale Face and surrounding areas) - (Penalty – exclusion from the Trial results).
- 9 Anyone experiencing symptoms of Covid-19 must not attend the event.
- 10 Entries to be received no later than the closing date (**Tuesday 24 December 2024**).
- 11 Rider's performance in Observed Sections will be recorded electronically. No punch cards will be issued.
- 12 Ards & North Down Borough Council has requested that all event traffic turn left towards Bangor when exiting Whitespots car park and that those attending the event should avoid parking on the Dual Carriageway Hard Shoulder, in the interests of road safety. Overflow parking for competitors will be available within the grounds of the Somme Heritage Centre (PLEASE KEEP OFF THE GRASS).
- 13 Results will not be available immediately following the event, but will be posted on-line in due course.
